It removes from the 21 membership of the Commission To Study the Economic, Environmental and Energy 22 Benefits of Energy Storage to the Maine Electricity Industry representatives from small-23 scale and large-scale battery energy storage system owners and adds representatives from 24 small-scale and large-scale energy storage system owners. It removes certain language 25 regarding invited staff support.

The general operating expenses of this study are projected to be \$1,375 in fiscal year 2017-18 and \$1,375 in fiscal year 2018-19. The Legislature's budget includes approximately \$7,000 in fiscal year 2017-18 and \$10,000 in fiscal year 2018-19 for legislative studies. Whether these amounts are sufficient to fund all studies will depend on the number of studies authorized by the Legislative Council and the Legislature. The additional costs of providing staffing assistance to the study during the interim can be absorbed utilizing existing budgeted staff resources.
