SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 643,
L.D. 1744, Bill, "An Act To Create the Hire American Tax Credit for Businesses That
Hire Residents of the United States"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §2729 in subsection 2 in paragraph C in the
last line (page 2, line 2 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "taxes." the
following: 'This paragraph may not be construed to require a business employed by the
landowner in the harvesting of timber to be assessed personal property taxes in order for
the landowner to be eligible for the credit under this section.'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that a business employed by a landowner in the harvesting
timber is not required to be assessed personal property taxes in order for the landowner to
be eligible for the credit.
