COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1269, L.D. 1827, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Maine Uniform Trust Code Regarding Reporting by Trustees and the Duties of Trustees to Settlers"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 5 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "modify" the following: 'one or more of'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "subsection 1 or 2 or 3" and inserting the following: 'subsection subsections 1 or 2 and 3'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment clarifies that the settlor of a trust has authority to waive one or more of the trustee's duties that are listed in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 18-B, section 813, subsections 1, 2 and 3 with regard to giving notice, information and reports to qualified beneficiaries.
