

11 12	Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2 by striking out all of paragraph C (page 1, lines 24 to 34 in L.D.) and inserting the following:
13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23	'C. "Covered electronic device" means a computer central processing unit, a desktop printer, a video game console, a cathode ray tube, a cathode ray tube device, a flat panel display or similar video display device with a screen that is greater than 4 inches measured diagonally and that contains one or more circuit boards. "Covered electronic device" does not include an automobile ₅ : a household appliance ₅ ; a large piece of commercial or industrial equipment, such as commercial medical equipment, that contains a cathode ray tube, a cathode ray tube device, a flat panel display or similar video display device that is contained within, and is not separate from, the larger piece of equipment, or; other medical devices as that term is defined under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act; or a cellular telephone subject to section 2143 .'

25 26	This amendment removes the change in the definition of "covered electronic device" regarding video display devices as proposed in the bill.
