Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes General Fund deappropriations of \$26,102 in fiscal year 2017-18 and \$107,267 in fiscal year 2018-19 and Highway Fund deallocations of \$3,037 in fiscal year 2017-18 and \$12,149 in fiscal year 2018-19 for a management reorganization within the Department of Public Safety. It also includes Other Special Revenue Funds allocations of \$41,001 in fiscal year 2017-18 and \$164,002 in fiscal year 2018-19 for this reorganization.
