SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 712, L.D. 1869, Bill, "An Act To Establish the Total Cost of Education and the State and Local Contributions to Education for Fiscal Year 2018-19 and To Provide That Employees of School Management and Leadership Centers Are Eligible To Participate in the Maine Public Employees Retirement System"

Amend the amendment in the first indented paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 15 in amendment) by striking out the following: "8.49" and inserting the following: '8.48'

Amend the amendment in section 4 in that part relating to **Enhancing student performance and opportunity pursuant to Title 20-A, section 15688-A and section 15672, subsection 1-D** in the 4th line (page 4, line 36 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$51,500,000" and inserting the following: '\$53,500,000'

Amend the amendment in section 4 in that part relating to **Enhancing student performance and opportunity pursuant to Title 20-A, section 15688-A and section 15672, subsection 1-D** in the 17th line (page 5, line 12 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$4,000,000" and inserting the following: '\$2,000,000'

Amend the amendment by adding after section 5 the following:

'Amend the bill by adding after section 7 the following:

**'Sec. 8. Allocation for career and technical education center or career and technical education region.** For the purposes of calculating the total allocation for a career and technical education center or career and technical education region, any cap on the total allocation does not apply for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018 and ending June 30, 2019 only.'

SUMMARY

This amendment does the following.


1. It changes the mill expectation from 8.49 to 8.48.
2. It increases the allocation for career and technical education costs by \$2,000,000.
3. It decreases the allocation for alignment of career and technical education programs with national industry standards by \$2,000,000.

## Fiscal Note

Amends 2018-2019 allocations for funding total cost of K-12 public education

### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment amends the allocations for funding the total cost of K-12 public education in 2018-2019 by increasing the allocation for career and technical education costs by \$2,000,000 and decreasing the allocation for national industry standards for career and technical education by the same amount. This amendment does not change the total cost of funding K-12 public education in fiscal year 2018-19 or the State's share of that cost.
