COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 712, L.D. 1869, Bill, "An Act To Establish the Total Cost of Education and the State and Local Contributions to Education for Fiscal Year 2018-19 and To Provide That Employees of School Management and Leadership Centers Are Eligible To Participate in the Maine Public Employees Retirement System"

Amend the bill in section 3 in the last line (page 3, line 41 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "8.51" and inserting the following: '8.49'

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 4 and 5 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 4. Total cost of funding public education from kindergarten to grade 12. The total cost of funding public education from kindergarten to grade 12 for fiscal year 2018-19 is as follows:

13 **SUMMARY**

14 This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Education
15 and Cultural Affairs. The amendment makes several changes to the total cost of funding
16 public education from kindergarten to grade 12, the state contribution and the local
17 contribution for fiscal year 2018-19, including:

18 1. Reducing the mill expectation rate for municipalities from 8.51 to 8.49 for fiscal
19 year 2018-19 since the proposed allocation for career and technical education middle
20 school programs for fiscal year 2018-19 is reduced by \$2,500,000 overall since:

21 A. The proposed allocation for career and technical education middle school
22 programs is reduced from \$5,000,000 to \$500,000 for fiscal year 2018-19; and

23 B. The allocation for the national industry standards for career and technical
24 education programs for fiscal year 2018-19 is upgraded from \$2,000,000 to
25 \$4,000,000;

26 2. Transferring the provision of the adjustments from the state share of the total
27 allocation pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 15689 to the audit
28 adjustment pursuant to Title 20-A, section 15689, subsection 4; and

29 3. Amending the provisions regarding:

30 A. The state contribution to the total cost of teacher retirement by indicating that the
31 total costs include the unfunded actuarial liabilities of the Maine Public Employees
32 Retirement System that are attributable to teachers and the total costs exclude the
33 normal cost of teacher retirement; and

34 B. The state contribution to the total cost of funding public education from
35 kindergarten to grade 12 by indicating that the total costs include the state
36 contribution to the total cost of unfunded actuarial liabilities of the Maine Public
37 Employees Retirement System that are attributable to teachers, teacher retirement
38 health insurance and teacher retirement life insurance.

Fiscal Note

Establishes 2018-2019 allocations for funding total cost of K-12 public education

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill establishes the allocations for funding the total cost of K-12 public education in 2018-2019 including the state contribution of \$1,115,378,083. Because General Fund appropriations and Other Special Revenue Funds allocations totaling this amount for the State's share of funding K-12 public education for fiscal year 2018-19 were provided in Public Law 2017, c. 284, the 2018-2019 biennial budget, no additional funding is required.
