L.D. 1884, Bill, "An Act To Create a Community Protection Order To Allow Courts To

Amend the amendment by striking out all of Part C and inserting the following:

PART C

Sec. C-1. Entry of court orders. Until a case management system for the
judicial branch is fully operational, any orders issued by a court pursuant to this Act must
be forwarded on the same business day by e-mail to the Department of Public Safety for
entry into the electronic records management system maintained by the department.

PART D

Sec. D-1. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and
allocations are made.

SUMMARY

This amendment requires any orders issued by a court pursuant to the requirements of this legislation to be forwarded on the same business day by e-mail to the Department of Public Safety for entry into the electronic records management system maintained by the department. This requirement expires once a case management system for the judicial branch is fully operational.

This amendment also provides funding to the Department of Public Safety for this entry of the orders.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

The amendment eliminates the need for a one-time appropriation of \$281,000 in fiscal year 2018-19 for the Judicial Department for programming and related information technology costs for changes to the department's case management system.

The amendment adds a General Fund appropriation and a Highway Fund allocation of \$273,000 and \$147,000, respectively, in fiscal year 2018-19 to the Department of Public Safety for one-time programming costs to develop and create an electronic records management system.
