15 16 17	A-1. A pharmacist may prescribe and dispense naloxone hydrochloride in accordance with protocols established under Title 32, section 13815 to an individual of any age at risk of experiencing an opioid-related drug overdose.

30 31 32 33	This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, clarifies that a pharmacist must follow protocols adopted by the Maine Board of Pharmacy when that pharmacist prescribes and dispenses naloxone hydrochloride to an individual of any age who is at risk of experiencing an opioid-related drug overdose; who is a member of the

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immediate family of, or a friend of, an individual at risk of experiencing an opioid-related

drug overdose; or who is in a position to assist an individual at risk of experiencing an opioid-related drug overdose.

In addition, this amendment makes technical changes so as to conform with the effect of Public Law 2017, chapter 364.
