
Amend the amendment by inserting after section 1 the following:

Amend the bill in section 2 in §4710 in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 24 in
L.D.) by striking out the following: "shall" and inserting the following: 'may' '

The bill requires school administrative units to enhance and upgrade the system of
response to intervention for students by the school year that begins in the fall of 2019.
This amendment authorizes school administrative units to do so.
