11 12	Amend the Senate Order in the Ordered paragraph in the last line by striking out the following: "them." and inserting the following: 'them; and be it further'
13	Amend the Senate Order by adding at the end the following:
14 15 16 17	'ORDERED, that the President of the Senate shall appoint a 6-member panel consisting of 3 members of the Senate from the party holding the greatest number of seats in the Senate and 3 members from the party holding the 2nd greatest number of seats in the Senate; and be it further
18 19 20 21	ORDERED, that prior to taking any action authorized by this order, other than the appointment of the 6-member panel pursuant to the immediately preceding paragraph, the President of the Senate shall obtain the approval of a majority of the members of the 6-member panel appointed pursuant to this order; and be it further
22 23	ORDERED , that the authorization granted to the President of the Senate by this order expires 45 days after passage by the Senate.'
24	SUMMARY
25 26 27 28	This amendment requires the President of the Senate to appoint a 6-member panel consisting of an equal number of members of the 2 parties holding the greatest number of seats in the Senate, and requires the President of the Senate to obtain the approval of a majority of the panel prior to taking any action authorized by the order, other than the

appointment of the 6-member panel. This amendment also specifies that the authorization granted by the order expires 45 days after passage of the order by the Senate.
