	COMMITTEE AMENDMENT 10 H.F. 10, L.D. 13
1 2	paragraph, "grocery store" has the same meaning as in Title 22, section 2491, subsection 7-B.
3 4	Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2 by striking out all of the last paragraph (page 2, lines 29 to 31 in L.D.) and inserting the following:
5 6 7	'This subsection does not exempt the businesses or facilities specified in sections 3205 and 3207 from closing in any municipality until the requirements of those sections have been met.'
8 9 10	Amend the bill in section 2 in §3210 in the first paragraph in the first line (page 2, line 34 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "with" the following: 'more than 5,000 square feet but'
11 12 13	Amend the bill in section 2 in §3210 in the first paragraph in the 3rd line (page 2, line 36 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "subsection" and inserting the following: 'section'
14	Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency clause.
15 16	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
17	SUMMARY
18 19 20	This amendment places a threshold of 5,000 square feet on a grocery store that may be open on Easter, Thanksgiving or Christmas, if approved by the municipality, and removes the emergency preamble and emergency clause.
