1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §13071-A, sub-§4, ¶A,** as enacted by PL 2003, c. 655, Pt. B,
3 §384 and affected by §422, is amended to read:

4 A. A person may not operate a personal watercraft on:

5 (1) Mud Pond, Oversett Pond, South Pond, Round Pond, Twitchell Pond, Hicks
6 Pond, Indian Pond or Furlong Pond in the Town of Greenwood in Oxford
7 County;

8 (2) North Pond or Bryant Pond, also known as Christopher Lake, in the Town of
9 Greenwood and the Town of Woodstock in Oxford County;

10 (3) Concord Pond, Little Concord Pond or Shagg Pond in the Town of
11 Woodstock in Oxford County;

12 (4) Hamilton Pond in Bar Harbor in Hancock County;

13 (5) Bog Lake or Horseshoe Lake in the Town of Northfield in Washington
14 County;

15 (6) Megunticook Lake in the Town of Camden and the Town of Hope in Knox
16 County and the Town of Lincolnville in Waldo County;

17 (7) Hobbs Pond, Fish Pond or Alford Lake in the Town of Hope in Knox
18 County;

19 (8) Norton Pond or Coleman Pond in the Town of Lincolnville in Waldo County;

20 (9) Pitcher Pond in the Town of Lincolnville and the Town of Northport in
21 Waldo County;

22 (10) Torsey Lake in the Town of Mount Vernon and the Town of Readfield in
23 Kennebec County;

24 (11) Trickey Pond in the Town of Naples in Cumberland County;

25 (12) Brandy Pond in the Town of Naples in Cumberland County between sunset
26 and 9:00 a.m.;

27 (13) Fulton Lake in the Town of Northfield in Washington County;

28 (14) Knight Pond in the Town of Northport in Waldo County;

29 (15) Moose Pond or Saturday Pond in the Town of Otisfield in Oxford County;

30 (16) Tripp Pond, Upper Range Pond or Middle Range Pond in the Town of
31 Poland in Androscoggin County;

32 (17) Keewaydin Lake, Virginia Lake, Trout Pond, Weymouth Pond or Whitney
33 Pond in the Town of Stoneham in Oxford County;

34 (18) Lermond Pond in the Town of Union and the Town of Hope in Knox

36 (19) Pocasset Lake or Pickerel Pond in the Town of Wayne in Kennebec County;

- 1 (20) Androscoggin Lake in the Town of Wayne in Kennebec County and the
2 Town of Leeds in Androscoggin County;
- 3 (21) Little Cobbosseecontee Lake in the Town of Winthrop in Kennebec County;

- 16 (29) Nicatous Lake in the Townships of T40 MD, T41 MD and T3 ND in
17 Hancock County;
- 18 (30) Crystal Lake in the Town of Washington in Knox County;
- 19 (31) Middle Branch Pond in the Town of Waterboro in York County;
- 20 (32) Highland Lake or Woods Pond in the Town of Bridgton in Cumberland
21 County if the personal watercraft is rented and does not display a decal
22 identifying the rental agency that owns the personal watercraft; ~~or~~
- 23 (33) Lake St. George in the Town of Liberty; or
- 24 (34) Lower Wilson Pond in the Town of Greenville or Upper Wilson Pond in the
25 Town of Greenville and Bowdoin College Grant West Township in Piscataquis
26 County.
