This amendment also adds an appropriation of funds to stabilize the workforce by bringing salaries of home visitors in line with comparable positions. It reduces the additional funding provided in the bill for home visiting services from \$4,000,000 for fiscal year 2019-20 and \$3,000,000 for fiscal year 2020-21 to \$500,000 for each year and provides that the funding must be used to reduce any waiting lists for home visiting services.
