Report. Resolved: That the Department of Education shall study the 15 16 special education funding component of the essential programs and services funding formula pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, chapter 606-B and report its 17 18 findings to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over 19 education matters no later than January 15, 2021. The report must include, but is not limited to, an examination of the special education budgetary hardship adjustment 20 21 pursuant to Title 20-A, section 15689, subsection 15 and recommendations on how to 22 make that adjustment more responsive to the needs of schools and an update on any 23 review of the special education funding component that the department conducts in conjunction with the Maine Education Policy Research Institute. The joint standing 24 25 committee may report out a bill relating to the subject matter of the report to the First 26 Regular Session or Second Regular Session of the 130th Legislature. 27 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively. 28 **SUMMARY** 29 This amendment, which strikes and replaces the bill with a resolve, requires the 30 31 Department of Education to study and report to the joint standing committee of the 32 Legislature having jurisdiction over education matters on the department's continued
