3 **SUMMARY**

4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 This bill proposes to enact measures designed to make the Department of Education's
6 Maine Learning Technology Initiative, or "MLTI," more cost-effective for schools and
7 for the State, thus allowing participation by increased numbers of students. The cost-
8 saving measures may include, but are not limited to, eliminating the ability of school
9 administrative units to choose higher-cost technology options.
