1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 **CONCEPT DRAFT** 3 **SUMMARY** This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208. 4 5 This bill proposes to enact measures designed to make the Department of Education's Maine Learning Technology Initiative, or "MLTI," more cost-effective for schools and 6 for the State, thus allowing participation by increased numbers of students. The cost-7 saving measures may include, but are not limited to, eliminating the ability of school 8 administrative units to choose higher-cost technology options. 9
