- COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" " to S.P. 41, L.D. 154, Bill, "An Act To Amend 9 the Law Governing MaineCare Coverage of Chiropractic Treatment" 10
 - Amend the bill by adding after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. State plan amendment. No later than January 1, 2020, the Department of Health and Human Services shall apply to the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services for a state plan amendment to allow for Medicaid reimbursement for all chiropractic services performed by chiropractic doctors licensed under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 32, chapter 9 within their scope of practice.

Sec. 4. Contingent effective date. That section of this Act that amends the 18 19 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 3174-AAA, subsection 1 does not take effect unless: 20

21 The United States Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for 1. Medicare and Medicaid Services approves a state plan amendment to allow for Medicaid 22 23 reimbursement for all chiropractic services performed by chiropractic doctors licensed 24 under Title 32, chapter 9 within their scope of practice; and

25 2. The Commissioner of Health and Human Services notifies the Secretary of State, the Secretary of the Senate, the Clerk of the House of Representatives and the Revisor of 26 Statutes that written approval for the state plan amendment has been received.

Sec. 5. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and 28 allocations are made. 29

32 Initiative: Provides funding to allow for all chiropractic services that are within the scope 33 of practice of chiropractic doctors and performed by a licensed chiropractic doctor to be reimbursed under the MaineCare program. 34

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, requires the 13 14 Department of Health and Human Services to apply for a state plan amendment to allow 15 for Medicaid reimbursement for all chiropractic services within the scope of practice of chiropractic doctors no later than January 1, 2020. If the state plan amendment is not 16 17 approved by the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, chiropractic doctors will not be reimbursed by 18 MaineCare for any additional chiropractic services not currently eligible for 19 reimbursement. The amendment also adds an appropriations and allocations section. 20

Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$128,684 in fiscal year 2019-20 and \$257,367 in fiscal year 2020-21 to allow for all chiropractic services that are within the scope of practice of chiropractic doctors and performed by a licensed chiropractic doctor to be reimbursed under the MaineCare program. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations are also included for the FMAP match.

There is a potential for savings which could mitigate the new costs above from individuals currently receiving services in a higher cost setting who may choose to receive services from a lower cost chiropractor and savings from individuals who choose the chiropractic setting initially for a new service. As it is not known how often this may occur no estimate of the potential savings is made at this time.
