The maximum child occupancy of an outdoor play area may not exceed the number of children allowed in the outdoor play area in accordance with the usable space per child requirement in this section, except during infrequent community gatherings and large group celebrations.

34 35	This bill requires a child care facility to provide an outdoor play area that provides a minimum net area of 45 square feet of usable space per child.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
