9	Sec. 3. 35-A MRSA §3136, sub-§2, ¶F is enacted to read:
10 11 12 13	F. Lands or easements to be acquired for the purpose of an elective transmission upgrade that is not required for reliability of service to customers in the State or the ISO-NE region. For purposes of this paragraph, "ISO-NE region" has the same meaning as in section 1902, subsection 3.

15 16 17 18	This bill withholds the right of eminent domain from a transmission and distribution utility for lands or easements to be acquired for an elective transmission upgrade that is not required for reliability of service to customers in the State or the ISO-New England region.
