9	COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 216, L.D. 292, Bill, "An Act To Feed
10	Maine's Residents by Allowing Dairy Dealers and Producers in the State To Donate Fresh
11	Milk to Food Banks in the State"
12	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the
13	following:
14	Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §2964 is enacted to read:
15	§2964. Donations of fresh milk to food banks
16	The minimum price provisions of this chapter do not apply to donations of fresh milk
17	produced and processed within the State by a dealer or producer-dealer to an incorporated
18	nonprofit organization within the State established for the purpose of reducing hunger and
19	increasing food security. Donations under this section may occur only if the fresh milk
20	produced and processed within the State to be donated does not have a wholesale or retail
21	market that will provide a higher monetary value to the dealer or producer-dealer.'
22	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
23	section number to read consecutively.
24	SUMMARY
25	This amendment, which is the majority report, strikes and replaces the bill. The
26	amendment exempts from the Maine Milk Commission's minimum price requirements
27	donations of fresh milk produced and processed within the State by a dealer or producer-
28	dealer to an incorporated nonprofit organization in the State established for the purpose of
29	reducing hunger and increasing food security. The amendment also provides that these
30	donations may occur only if the fresh milk produced and processed within the State to be
31 32	donated does not have a wholesale or retail market that will provide a higher monetary value to the dealer or producer-dealer.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill exempts fresh milk produced and processed in the State that is donated to nonprofit organizations established for the purpose of reducing hunger and increasing food security from the minimum price requirements of the Maine Milk Commission (MMC), if the donation does not have a wholesale or retail market that will provide a higher monetary value to the producer-dealer of fresh milk. Any additional costs to the MMC within the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Foresty resulting from this exemption are anticipated to be minor and can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.
