1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6422, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:
3	1-A. Validation of experience. The commissioner shall allow a person with ar
4	apprentice lobster and crab fishing license or a student lobster and crab fishing license to
5	demonstrate program completion through documentation that the license holder has
6	verified landings of at least 4,000 pounds of lobster over a period of not less than 2 years
7	Nothing in this subsection prohibits the commissioner from establishing additional
8	methods for a person with an apprentice lobster and crab fishing license or a studen
9	lobster and crab fishing license to demonstrate program completion.
10	SUMMARY

This bill requires the Commissioner of Marine Resources to allow a person with an apprentice lobster and crab fishing license or a student lobster and crab fishing license to demonstrate apprentice program completion through verified landings of at least 4,000 pounds of lobster over a period of not less than 2 years.
