1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §13068-A, sub-§17 is enacted to read:
3	17. Unattended watercraft. A person may not leave a watercraft unattended. A
4	watercraft is unattended if it is in open water and not in the immediate control of the
5	operator.
6	A. A person who violates this subsection commits a civil violation for which a fine
7	of not less than \$100 nor more than \$500 may be adjudged.
8	SUMMARY
9	This bill makes a person's leaving a watercraft unattended in open water a civil
10	violation.
