STATE OF MAINE 5 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 6 7 129TH LEGISLATURE FIRST REGULAR SESSION 8 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 271, L.D. 345, Bill, "An Act To Help 9 10 New Teachers Succeed" Amend the bill in section 2 in §13201 in subsection 2 in paragraph A in the first 4 11 lines (page 1, lines 32 to 35 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "of 3 years, or if a 12 probationary teacher has not received a summative effectiveness rating indicating 13 14 ineffectiveness pursuant to chapter 508 during the first or 2nd year of the probationary 15 teacher's contract after a probationary period of 2 years" Amend the bill in section 2 in §13201 in subsection 2 in paragraph C in the first line 16 17 (page 2, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "of 2 or 3 years, in accordance with 18 paragraph A" 19 Amend the bill in section 2 in §13201 in subsection 2 by inserting at the end the 20 following: 21 'For purposes of this subsection, "probationary period" means a period of 3 years, except that for any teacher hired for the 2020-2021 school year or any subsequent year, 22 "probationary period" means a period not to exceed 2 years." 23 Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 3 to 5. 24 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or 25 26 section number to read consecutively. SUMMARY 27 This amendment requires that, beginning with teachers hired for the 2020-2021 28 29 school year, the probationary period may not exceed 2 years. This amendment removes 30 the sections of the bill that enacted special procedures for probationary teachers. 31 The bill as amended includes a restructuring of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 32 20-A, section 13201 to bring the section into conformity with current drafting standards.
