Beginning January 1, 1999, a A motor vehicle that is 10 required to be registered in Cumberland County and that is subject to inspection pursuant to subsection 1 must have an annual a biennial enhanced inspection. The fuel tank cap on 1974 and subsequent models of gasoline-powered vehicles; 14 15 and C. The on-board diagnostic system on 1996 and subsequent models. 16 17 A motor vehicle that is not required to be registered in Cumberland County may have an enhanced inspection under this subsection. 18 **SUMMARY** 19 20 This bill changes noncommercial automobile inspection requirements from an annual inspection to a biennial inspection. 21
