Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$1,672,638 in fiscal year 2019-20 and \$3,113,728 in fiscal year 2020-21 to allow the MaineCare reimbursement rate for direct care workers for adults with intellectual disabilities or autism to be at least 125% of the state minimum wage. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations are also included for the FMAP match and Other Special Revenue Funds allocations are included for the service provider tax.
