COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 326, L.D. 417, Bill, "An Act To Allow an Attorney To Copy a Driver's License"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'An Act To Allow an Attorney To Use a Photocopied Driver's License To Consummate a Financial Transaction'**

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

**'Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2103, sub-§4, ¶B,** as enacted by PL 2003, c. 568, §1, is amended to read:

B. A driver's license solely for proof of identification for the consummation of a financial transaction conducted by either the driver or the driver's attorney;

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment replaces the bill and changes the title. Current law authorizes the photocopying of a driver's license solely for proof of identification for the consummation of a financial transaction. The amendment revises current law to provide that either the driver or the driver's attorney can consummate a financial transaction using the photocopied driver's license for identification.
