Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§78, as repealed and replaced by PL 1997, c. 725, §1, is amended to read:

78. Farm animal bedding, hay and baling supplies. Sales of organic bedding materials for farm animals and, hay and baling twine, net and wrapping for hay.

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act takes effect October 1, 2019.

SUMMARY

This bill provides a sales tax exemption for baling twine, net and wrapping for hay.
