2 3	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§78, as repealed and replaced by PL 1997, c. 725, §1, is amended to read:
4 5	78. Farm animal bedding, hay and baling supplies. Sales of organic bedding materials for farm animals and, hay and baling twine, net and wrapping for hay.
6	Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act takes effect October 1, 2019.

8	This bill provides a sales tax exemption for baling twine, net and wrapping for hay.
