2	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2053, sub-§9 is enacted to read:
3	9. Yield to transit buses. An operator of a vehicle must yield the right-of-way to a
4	transit bus traveling in the same direction if the transit bus has signaled and is reentering
5	the traffic flow from a bus stop or shoulder of the roadway. This subsection does not
6	relieve the operator of a transit bus from the duty to drive with due regard for the safety
7	of all persons using the roadway. For purposes of this subsection, "transit bus" means a
8	bus operated by a public mass transit operator and does not include a school bus.
9	SUMMARY
10	This bill requires an operator of a vehicle to yield the right-of-way to a transit bus
11	traveling in the same direction if the transit bus has signaled and is reentering the traffic
