L.D. 459, Bill, "An Act To Include Homelessness in the Laws Governing Emergency

This amendment removes the requirement that the Department of Health and Human Services must reimburse municipalities 100% of direct GA costs after a person has spent 90 consecutive nights homeless. This will decrease the amount of additional assistance payments made by municipalities due to this bill.
