2	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §4003, sub-§3, as amended by PL 2017, c. 470, §1, is further
3	amended to read:
4	3. Rehabilitation and reunification as a priority. Require that reasonable best
5	efforts be made to rehabilitate and reunify families as a means for protecting the welfare
6	of children, but prevent needless delay for permanent plans for children when
7	rehabilitation and reunification is not possible;
8	SUMMARY
9	This bill amends the Child and Family Services and Child Protection Act to require
10	that best efforts, rather than reasonable efforts, be made by the Department of Health and
11	Human Services to rehabilitate and reunify families as a means of protecting the welfare
12	of children.
