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7 8 homebound individuals. The amendment also clarifies that the demonstration waiver for medically tailored foods applies to individuals who are 60 years of age or older, homebound and at risk for readmission to a health care facility. It changes the date for reporting on the 2-year pilot project to January 1, 2023 and clarifies that the pilot project goes forward only if the waiver is approved by the Federal Government.

The amendment also includes an appropriations and allocations section.

#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$65,656 in fiscal year 2019-20 and \$50,647 in fiscal year 2020-21 for reimbursement for 2 weeks of medically tailored food and nutrition interventions for certain inpatients at high risk of readmission and one-time funding for Maine Integrated Health Management System technology changes required to process medically tailored meals claims. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations are also included for the FMAP match.
