11	Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting the following:
12 13	'Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §2231, sub-§3, as amended by PL 2019, c. 12, Pt. B, §1, is further amended to read:
14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21 22	3. Application. A person desiring to grow hemp for commercial purposes shall apply to the commissioner for a license on a form prescribed by the commissioner. The application must include the name and address of the applicant, the legal description of the land area <u>or indoor facility</u> to be used for the production of hemp and a map, an aerial photograph or global positioning coordinates sufficient for locating the production fields <u>or the floor plan of any indoor facility</u> . For purposes of this subsection, "indoor facility" includes a building, greenhouse, cold frame, hoop house, high tunnel, floating row cover <u>or other agricultural or horticultural method of extending the growing season by enclosing the growing area</u> .'
23 24	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

26 27 28	This amendment clarifies that an indoor facility includes a building, greenhouse, cold frame, hoop house, high tunnel, floating row cover or other agricultural or horticultural methods of extending the growing season by enclosing the growing area.
