A, §37, is 16 further amended to read: 17 2. Litter. "Litter" means all waste materials including, but not limited to, bottles, 18 glass, crockery, cans, scrap metal, junk, paper, garbage, rubbish, offal, except waste parts 19 20 or remains resulting from the normal field dressing of lawfully harvested wild game or 21 the lawful use of waste parts or remains of wild game as bait, feathers, except feathers 22 from live birds while being transported, abandoned ice-fishing shacks, old automobiles or 23 parts of automobiles or similar refuse, or disposable packages or containers thrown or 24 deposited as prohibited in this chapter, but not including the wastes of the primary 25 processes of mining, logging, sawmilling, farming or manufacturing. "Litter" includes waste materials resulting from or associated with the use of tobacco products, including, 26 but not limited to, cigarette butts. 27 For the purposes of this subsection, "tobacco product" has the same meaning as in Title 28 22, section 1551, subsection 3.1 29 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or 30 section number to read consecutively. 31 SUMMARY 32 This amendment changes the title of and replaces the bill, which is a concept draft. It 33 amends the State's litter laws, to clarify that waste materials resulting from or associated 34
