An Act To Enhance Highway Safety by Strengthening the So-called Move Over Law

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2054, sub-§9, as amended by PL 2015, c. 32, §4, is further
 amended to read:

- 9. Stationary vehicles. The operator of a vehicle passing a stationary authorized
 emergency vehicle using an emergency light or a stationary public service vehicle using
 its authorized lights, with due regard to the safety and traffic conditions, shall:
- A. Pass in a lane not adjacent to that of the authorized emergency vehicle or public
 service vehicle, if possible; or
- 9 B. If passing in a nonadjacent lane is impossible or unsafe, pass the emergency 10 vehicle or public service vehicle at a careful and prudent speed reasonable for passing 11 the authorized emergency vehicle or public service vehicle safely.
- A violation of this subsection is a traffic infraction for which a minimum fine of \$250
 \$350 must be adjudged.

SUMMARY

This bill increases from \$250 to \$350 the minimum fine for passing a stationary authorized emergency vehicle using an emergency light or a stationary public service vehicle using its authorized lights and failing to pass in a lane that is not adjacent to the stationary vehicle or, if passing in a nonadjacent lane would be impossible or unsafe, failing to pass at a careful and prudent speed.
