COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 170, L.D. 548, Bill, "An Act To Prohibit a Person under 18 Years of Age from Being Charged with the Crime of Engaging in Prostitution"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'An Act Regarding Charging a Person under 18 Years of Age with the Crime of Engaging in Prostitution'**

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the first line (page 1, line 4 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "is 18 years of age or older" and inserting the following: "has in fact attained 18 years of age"

**SUMMARY**

This amendment changes the title of the bill and conforms the reference to a person's age to the drafting standards of the Maine Criminal Code.
