4	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
5	This bill proposes to enact measures designed to provide flexibility in the regulation
6	of development near the shore. The purpose of the bill is to encourage the development
7	of creative approaches to protect beaches and critical near-shore infrastructure threatened
8	by sea level rise and storm damage.
