'Amend the resolve by striking out all of the emergency preamble (page 1, lines 1 to 16 in L.D.)

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 18 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "July" and inserting the following: 'November'

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 3 (page 1, lines 12 to 20 in amendment) and inserting the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved: That the following appropriations and allocations are made.
