1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §12659-A, sub-§4, as amended by PL 2009, c. 214, §10, is further amended to read:
4 5	4. Checking cusk lines. A person fishing through the ice for cusk in the nighttime shall visit at least once every hour <u>24 hours</u> all lines set by that person for cusk.
6 7	A. A person who violates this subsection commits a civil violation for which a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$500 may be adjudged.
8 9 10	B. A person who violates this subsection after having been adjudicated as having committed 3 or more civil violations under this Part within the previous 5-year period commits a Class E crime.
11	SUMMARY
12 13	This bill changes how often a person is required to check cusk lines while ice fishing from at least once every hour in the nighttime to at least once every 24 hours.
