1       **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2               **Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§103** is enacted to read:

3               **103. Career and technical student organizations.** Sales to nonprofit career and  
4 technical student organizations recognized by the Department of Education.

5               **Sec. 2. Effective date.** This Act takes effect October 1, 2019.

6   **SUMMARY**

7               This bill provides a sales tax exemption to nonprofit career and technical education  
8 student organizations recognized by the Department of Education.
