2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§103 is enacted to read:
3	103. Career and technical student organizations. Sales to nonprofit career and
4	technical student organizations recognized by the Department of Education.
5	Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act takes effect October 1, 2019.
