
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 538,
L.D. 733, Bill, "An Act To Promote Keeping Workers in Maine"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §599-A in subsection 3 in the 2nd line (page 2,
line 4 in amendment) by striking out the following: "300%" and inserting the following:
'400%'

SUMMARY

This amendment prohibits an employer from requiring or permitting an employee
earning wages at or below 400% of the federal poverty level, instead of at or below 300%
of the federal poverty level as in the committee amendment, to enter into a noncompete
agreement with the employer.
