## 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §13003, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is amended to read:

3. Exception. This section does not apply to teachers a teacher in a secondary
schools school approved under section 2901, subsection 2, paragraph A or a federal
Junior Reserve Officers' Training Corps instructor, pursuant to 10 United States Code,
Section 2031, certified by the United States Department of Defense providing Junior
Reserve Officers' Training Corps instruction to students in grade 9 to grade 12.

## **SUMMARY**

10 This bill exempts from teacher certification requirements a federal Junior Reserve 11 Officers' Training Corps instructor certified by the United States Department of Defense 12 providing Junior Reserve Officers' Training Corps instruction to students in grade 9 to 13 grade 12.
