Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill establishes 2 Paralegal positions and one Consumer Outreach position within the Maine Human Rights Commission and requires that the commission purchase a computer system. The bill includes General Fund appropriations of \$197,888 in fiscal year 2019-20 and \$249,483 in fiscal year 2020-21.
