#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- **Sec. 1. Technology.** The Maine Human Rights Commission shall purchase a computer system that, at a minimum, meets the specifications required by existing federal contracts and facilitates electronic data management by the commission, including making case status information available electronically to parties and their attorneys.
- **Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.
