Amend the bill in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 19 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "July" and inserting the following: 'October' '

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2 and inserting the following:

Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.
