13 14	2-B. Start time. A school administrative unit may authorize a secondary school in the unit to start a school day no earlier than 8:30 a.m.'
15 16	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
17	SUMMARY
18 19	This amendment allows a school administrative unit to authorize its secondary schools' school days to start no earlier than 8:30 a.m.
