Study establishment of a Maine School Safety Center, Resolved: 16 That the Department of Education shall study and make recommendations relating to 17 18 school safety and security, including, but not limited to, planning to mitigate the potential 19 risks associated with opening school facilities to the public when a school is used as a polling place and the establishment of a Maine School Safety Center based on a report 20 created by Safe Havens International pursuant to Resolve 2013, chapter 76, the top 21 recommendation of which was the establishment of such a center, as detailed in the Safe 22 23 Havens International report entitled "Excerpts from the School Security Reports Submitted to the Maine Department of Education January, 2014." The department shall 24 submit a preliminary report regarding the study with initial findings to the Joint Standing 25 Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs by December 15, 2019 and shall submit a 26 27 final report, including its recommendations relating to school safety and security and any 28 suggested legislation, to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education matters by December 15, 2020. The joint standing committee 29 may submit a bill to the First Regular Session of the 130th Legislature. 30 31 Amend the resolve by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively. 32 33 SUMMARY This amendment clarifies that the Department of Education is required to study and 34 make recommendations relating to school safety and security, including, but not limited 35
