SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 264,
L.D. 898, Bill, "An Act To Provide for a Professional Wage and Support for New
Educators"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Provide for Support for New Educators' '


Amend the amendment in the 3rd indented paragraph from the end on the first line
(page 2, line 15 in amendment) by striking out the following: "7 and" and inserting the
following: '5 to'

Amend the amendment in the 2nd indented paragraph from the end on the first line
(page 2, line 16 in amendment) by striking out the following: "section" and inserting the
following: 'sections 10 and'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter
or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the sections of the bill relating to establishing a minimum
salary of \$40,000 for certified teachers starting after June 30, 2020.

Eliminates current biennium cost increase - General Fund

Eliminates future biennium cost increase - School Administrative Units

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment removes the provisions in the bill that require local school administrative units (SAU's) to increase the minimum salary for certified teachers to \$40,000 beginning in fiscal year 2020-21 and that the state fund 100% of the incremental cost in fiscal year 2020-21, 66% of the incremental cost in fiscal year 2021-22 and 33% of the incremental cost in fiscal year 2022-23.

As amended, this bill has no fiscal impact on the State.
